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Introduction to Perspective

- Three drawings (sketch book okay)
 - o one point perspective of six boxes
 - o same composition of boxes but drawn at a significantly differently eye level
 - o two point perspective of box at several different eye levels
- Sketch book – drawings of everyday objects from different eye levels, outdoor and indoor observations with an eye towards perspective, experiment with perspective issues that challenge or confuse you

Portfolio Drawings

- One point perspective of a room in your house, use entire picture plane in considering your composition (homework)
- Two point perspective of building and surroundings (homework)
- Sighting exercise of box in class
- SOTA balcony outdoors
- A drawing from an unusual perspective (a still life will be set up in class)
- A fantasy landscape demonstrating all elements of perspective, Linear and Atmospheric

- o Consider placement of objects to indicate an awareness of space and create balance in your composition
- o Use elements of Atmospheric perspective to create and control sense of depth and create interest
