regarding grades and repeating courses in the **undergraduate business major core**

- Q.** I took FIN 350 in fall 2004 and got a D+. Do I need to take it again to raise my grade?
- A.** You do not have to retake it because it was before spring 2005. You may need to retake it if you do not have the necessary grades to enroll in BUS 690, see www.sfsu.edu/%7Emgmtwww/access/spring/access.html
- Q.** I took ISYS 363 and MGMT 407 in spring 2005 and got a D in both. Do I need to retake them and raise my grades to a C- or higher?
- A.** You must retake ISYS 363 but you do not need to retake MGMT 407.
- Q.** In which courses do I need a minimum grade of C- ?
- A.** DS 110, ECON 100 and 101, ACCT 100 and 101, DS 212, ISYS 263, FIN 350, BUS 360, ISYS 363/ACCT 307, MGMT 405, DS 412, MKTG 431.
- Q.** I got a D in BUS 682. Must I take it again to raise my grade?
- A.** No, because BUS 682 is no longer a prerequisite course to any business core course.
- Q.** I took a W in MGMT 405 last semester. Can I take a W in 405 this semester?
- A.** No. The College of Business allows only one W in a business major course.
- Q.** I got NC in DS 412, then a W and a D. Can I take it a 4th time to get the grade up to a C-?
- A.** No, not at SFSU. You may take an approved equivalent course at another university and transfer the credit to SFSU.
- Q.** I got a D in IBUS 330 in spring 2005. Do I need to retake it to raise my grade to a C-.
- A.** No. The College's C- minimum rule does not apply to IBUS 330.
