- Your presentation should be between 10 – 12 minutes in length
- The presenter must be at the conference at least 30 minutes prior to the presentation time

Abstract Information:

One hard copy of an abstract of the proposed presentation or poster must accompany the *abstract submission form* and be turned in to the **Psychology Department's main office (EP 301) no later than April 10, 2009**. The abstract should conform to the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (5th ed.) but can be up to 250 words in length. To allow for anonymous review of the proposals, the names of the submitters and any other identifying information should **ONLY** appear on the proposal abstract submission form. Instead, put the last four digits of your SFSU Student ID# at the top of each page of your abstract. *Proposals that do not adhere to this guideline will not be accepted.*
